Am I eligible for the service?

The online service is <u>not appropriate</u> for you, if:

- You are under 16 years old.
- You have symptoms of a sexually transmitted infection.
- You have already tested positive for an infection and need treatment.
- You require a vaccination e.g. Hepatitis A, B, or HPV.
- Someone you had sex with recently told you they have been diagnosed with an infection.
- You have recently been sexually assaulted.
- You need to start contraception (pills, IUS, IUD, Implant).
- You may need emergency contraception:
 If you've had unprotected sex and you are not using a contraception method at all / properly.
- You may need PEP (post exposure prophylaxis):
 - If you've had unprotected sex with someone you suspect / know is HIV positive.
 - If you've had unprotected anal intercourse in the last 72 hours.
- You require another service, such as PrEP, drug and alcohol support, or any of our specialist clinics.
